






 Designed to address community issues in a relatively quick and inexpensive manner, strengthening community ties along the way.






Success Factors for Citizens' Councils

- Willingness on part of sponsors to engage in a process with an open-ended outcome, and still commit to implementing at least some of the recommendations;
- The Dynamic Facilitation process creates psychological safety through empathy and reflective listening, and thus
 - o generates greater openness to different perspectives and
 - elicits creativity.

History of Citizens' Councils

- Were inspired by the "Wisdom
 Council" format developed by U. S.
 consultant Jim Rough, as a way to apply
 Dynamic Facilitation (DF) to large
 systems.
- Jim Rough developed DF while working as a Total Quality Improvement consultant with shop-floor workers at a sawmill in the Pacific Northwest.




History of Citizens' Councils, cont.

- Vorarlberg's Büro für Zukunftsfragen (Office of Future-Related Issues, or OFRI) developed the Wisdom Council model further, and renamed it "Bürgerrat".
- Sometimes we have called this Austrian model the "Civic Council", to honor the adaptations that OFRI made to the original model.
- With the OECD report, we are now calling it the "Citizens' Council".

The DF-based Wisdom Council also has significant applications for workplace democracy.





A randomly-selected group from a larger organization is able to surface "organizational elephants" in a creative and effective manner.

How can these processes accomplish so much in such a relatively short time?

- By working with empathy to build psychological safety, people are able to be more authentic and bring both mind & heart to the work
- This safety allows people's natural brilliance to emerge, and the group to enter into a creative flow
- By welcoming initial solutions from the beginning (without any rush to decision!) we work with the energy of participants' natural meaning-making process


Dynamic Facilitation is an open-source process


- We are doing our best to give it away! Some people are able to begin practicing from simply reading the manuals.
